### INFORMATION ON GENDER INTEGRATION IN LOCAL, NATIONAL, OR REGIONAL CLIMATE CHANGE ACTIONS.

Gender Analysis on Sexual and Reproductive Health and Resilience climatic:

- Climatic change impacts community resilience and limits access opportunities sexual and reproductive health services;
- Girls and women are most at risk and impacted by climate-related crises because they are responsible for supplying their homes with food, firewood and water, by social norms established and cultural practices

#### CLIMATE-RELATED PROGRAMS

The national strategy of gender and climate change:

- Integrate the gender dimension into all the processes of development, implementation and monitoring and evaluation of policies, strategies and programs relating to the climate;
- Build capacity for better participation of women in all climate actions

#### CLIMATE-RELATED PROGRAMS

- Promote the empowerment of women in all priority areas of climate change;
- Mobilize funding to strengthen the resilience of women and enable the achievement of the objectives of the Paris Agreement;
- Set up a system for collecting sexdisaggregated data and monitoring indicators for gender mainstreaming in climate actions

# THE CAPACITY AND POLICY GAPS THAT HINDER THE PARTICIPATION OF WOMEN, YOUTH, AND VULNERABLE GROUPS IN CLIMATE CHANGE-RELATED PROGRAMS

- The preponderance of local customs and traditions
- Multiplicity of documents;
- Rigidity of procedures

#### RECOMMENDATIONS

- Strengthen the household targeting process by targeting the categories of people most exposed and vulnerable to the negative consequences of climate change;
- give the main guidelines of the fight against climate change
- strengthen actions to combat climate change
- serve as a reference for the actions to be undertaken
- Improved data management, which is critical for better decision-making, preparation for future responses, and advocacy for improved responses to climate change in emergencies
