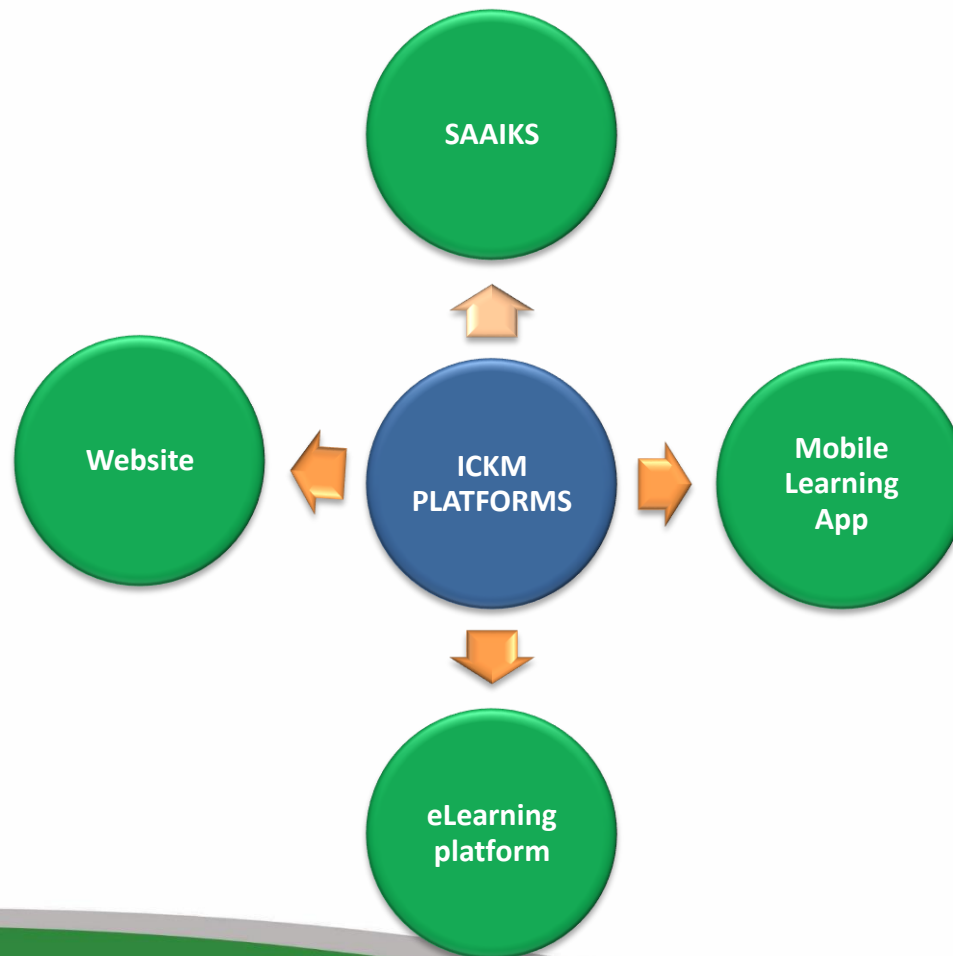

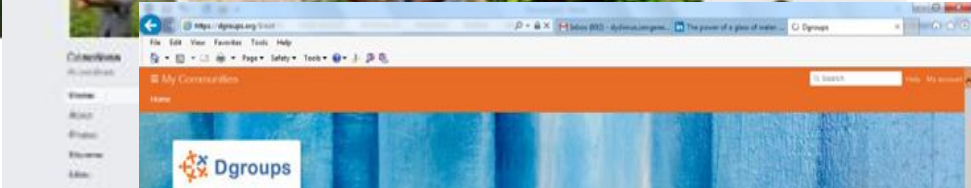

The suite of free, easy-to-access and engaging training materials includes an e-learning course and a toolkit, as well as a set of reports and recordings informed by a webinar series that saw about 150 participants over the summer of 2020. 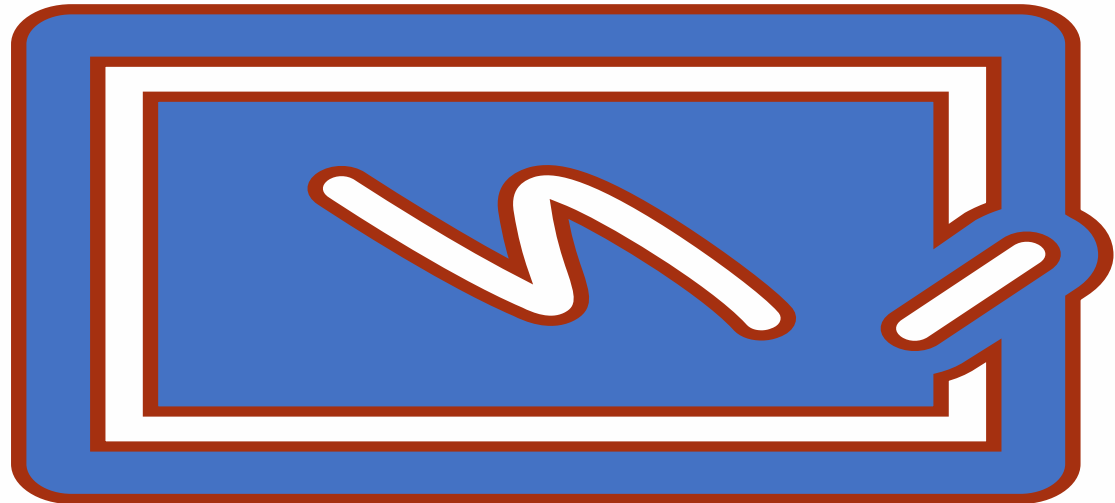
