 implementation of agricultural programmes and projects across Africa


Youth Engagement

About 85% of the young people live in developing countries, where agriculture is likely to provide the main source of income

- No role models in Agriculture
- Mindset that Agriculture is practiced by old & illiterate

- Active engagement in strategic partnerships
- **❖** Peer-to-peer communication crucial
- Implementation of existing policy interventions & strategic plans

The Role of CYN BW in implementation of CAADP/Malabo Declaration

- Development of a detailed data base and avail it to stakeholders in order to accurately measure youth participation.
- Creating sustainable farming enterprises, CYN BW through the joint effects of sector stakeholders intends to assist the farming youth in accessing land, funding and technologies that would ensure a consistent production and ultimately result in increased production
